

# List of CSS-recognised vaccinations.

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## Basis

Under mandatory healthcare insurance (OKP) and supplementary insurance (VVG), CSS pays for certain preventive vaccinations medically recognised in Switzerland according to the following CSS list (subject to change).

If the obligation to pay benefits does not derive from mandatory healthcare insurance, benefits are paid either from myFlex Outpatient Insurance or from the Health Account. The conditions for the payment and scope of benefits are governed by the General Insurance Conditions (AVB) and the Supplementary Conditions (ZB) of CSS for the insurance products in question.
